WITH HAIM ARONOVITZ

From classic sources on, a chronic tension has existed between the concepts of Exile and Redemption. Haim Aronovitz, Master Educator, will look at a series of classic and lesser-known texts and letters to see how Jews in the Diaspora relate to the state of Israel during ancient times as well as the present day. This program is offered as part of the Board of Jewish Education Marshall Jewish Learning Center's Israel Scholar in Residence program.

An outstanding and dynamic educator, Mr. Aronovitz works at the Hebrew University in Jerusalem's Melton Center for Jewish Education where he serves as the Deputy Director of the Florence Melton Adult Mini-School Institute, Director of Israel Seminars and Educational Director of the Senior Educators Program.

Mr. Aronovitz has led participants on inspiring trips to Israel. He uses classic texts, modern literature, maps and narratives to offer invaluable insights into Israeli culture and identity. Recently he has developed curriculum, using Israeli literature as the major tool for learning about Israeli society.

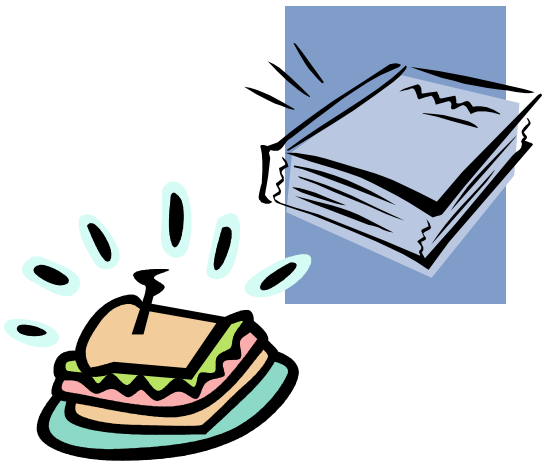
Don't miss this opportunity to explore the connection between Jews in the Diaspora and the state of Israel.
