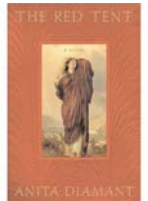

Get ready for an exciting and thought-provoking evening at Temple Jeremiah. This 80-minute independent documentary tells about a shocking act of forgiveness by Auschwitz survivor, Eva Mozes Kor, and the firestorm of criticism it created.



Eva and her twin sister, Miriam, were among the victims of Dr. Josef Mengele's cruel genetic experiments. The film follows Eva's transformation from embittered survivor to tireless advocate for reconciliation. It asks the question, "Can you forgive but not forget?"

In the season of the High Holy Days with the focus on atonement and repentance, this program will challenge ideas about forgiveness, compassion and community. Award-winning filmmaker Bob Hercules will lead a discussion following the movie.
